Call for the Excellence Awards for Interdepartmental Collaboration
for master's (with thesis) and doctoral students
in the fields of environment and sustainability

The Goldman-Sonnenfeld School of Sustainability and Climate Change aims to encourage interdepartmental research led by graduate and doctoral students. The School's Research Studies Committee will award prizes to master's and doctoral students **supervised by faculty members from two different departments**.*

The excellence prizes will be up to ILS 10,000 for master's students and up to ILS 15,000 for doctoral students.

Eligibility criteria for submitting applications:

Graduate or doctoral students with at least one year remaining to complete their research.

The School of Sustainability and Climate Change's Research Studies Committee will evaluate applications based on a combination of factors, including the degree of research interdisciplinarity, academic excellence, the contribution of the work to the fields of environment, sustainability, and climate change, and supporting the diverse research areas represented at the School.

The winners are required to participate in seminars, workshops, and research meetings organized by the School of Sustainability and Climate Change, which will take place several times each semester, particularly at the Research Studies Conference (June 8, 2025). Unjustified absence from any school activities will result in the cancellation and return of the prize.

*Taxation issues will be assessed on a case-by-case basis, and if applicable, taxes will be levied.
